## **LOUISVILLE PAVING & CONSTRUCTION CO. WINS NATIONAL AWARD FOR QUALITY IN ASPHALT PAVING**

Lanham, Md. — The National Asphalt Pavement Association (NAPA) announced today that Louisville Paving & Construction Co. of Louisville, Ky., won a 2016 Quality in Construction Award for excellence in construction of an asphalt pavement. The company received its award today at a ceremony during the association's 62<sup>nd</sup> Annual Meeting in Orlando.
